To determine the organisation's eligibility to participate in the <u>GOLD process</u> for 2019/2020, Barwon Health's smokefree initiative will be independently assessed against the Global Standards for Tobacco Free Healthcare Services.

We welcome experienced health service surveyor Anna Fletcher and support auditor Pauline Nolan (Bendigo Health) who will undertake the assessment across three days (Monday 1^{st} April – Wednesday 3^{rd} April).

The final day will feature presentations from many of Barwon Health's clinical teams who will share their relevant experiences and approaches in embedding smoking interventions into routine care.

This is a great opportunity for Barwon Health staff to see how the organisation has progressed in delivering safe quality care for tobacco and nicotine dependence, and for other VNSHS members to experience and learn from the international accreditation process. The program aims to be practical and interactive, and will include a walk-around of the University Hospital Geelong precinct.

The presentations will also be filmed and accessible via the VNSHS website and well as the Barwon Health One point site.


